Internship Programme at Salar Jung Museum

Invitation for Applications

The Salar Jung Museum in Hyderabad houses a remarkable collection of art and antiques from India, Europe, Asia, and the Far East. Most of its treasures were collected over forty years by Nawab Mir Yousuf Ali Khan, Salar Jung III, former Prime Minister of the Nizam VII. Today, the Museum has 40 galleries across Indian, Western, and Eastern blocks, showcasing rare objects of global origin. Its Library holds manuscripts and books in multiple languages, along with calligraphic panels.

The Salar Jung Museum invites applications for its Internship Programme from graduate and postgraduate students in Arts, Fine Arts, History, Museology, Conservation, Library, MCA, English, and related disciplines from candidates interested in museum studies or who are art enthusiasts. Selection will be made on the basis of merit and other criteria determined by the Museum, with the final selection to be made after the interview. Interns will be assigned tasks relevant to museum operations and collections.

Programme Details

- **Duration:** 3 to 6 months
- **Stipend and Certificate:**
 - Postgraduate interns: ₹5,000/- per month plus a certificate on successful completion
 - Graduate interns: Certificate on successful completion
- **Assignments:** Duties will be assigned based on the Museum's requirements and the intern's background and skills
- **Evaluation:** Performance will be assessed during and at the end of the internship

Eligibility and Selection

- **Educational Qualification:** Graduate or Postgraduate in Arts, History, MCA, English, Museology, Conservation, Library, MCA, English or related disciplines
- **Interest:** Candidates with an interest in museum studies, conservation, curation, documentation, education, public relations, or related museum outreach activities
- **Selection Criteria:** Shortlisting will be based on academic merit, relevance of background, statement of purpose, and other criteria as decided by the Museum
- **Selection Committee:** Applications will be scrutinised and reviewed by a committee comprising the Senior Guide Lecturer, Deputy Curator, and Curator of the Museum

Application Procedure

- Applications should be submitted through this Internship Programme
- Applicants must demonstrate a keen interest in museums/galleries and identify a specific area where they wish to work
- Each applicant must submit a brief bio along with a Statement of Purpose (SOP)
- Interns will be selected based on exhibitions and other projects of the Museum

- **Working Hours:** 9:30 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Saturday to Thursday. Interns are expected to be regular and punctual
- Any material produced during the internship will be the intellectual property of the Salar Jung Museum. If interns wish to use it for research, prior permission must be obtained and proper acknowledgement given
- A report and presentation must be submitted at the end of the internship period
- Interns will not be entitled to travel costs, accommodation, or other allowances during the internship
- Applications must be countersigned and bear the seal of the Head of the Institution where the applicant is studying
- Candidates should be prepared to work in a team environment
- Applications will be shortlisted based on qualifications and SOP. Shortlisted candidates will be interviewed by the Director / Curator Team of the Salar Jung Museum, Hyderabad

- **Deadline:** Applications must be received by **15th January 2026**
- **Interview:** Shortlisted candidates may be called for an interview or interaction. Final selection will be communicated in writing/email

Important Notes

- **Attendance and Conduct:** Interns are expected to follow Museum timings, rules, and code of conduct
- **Certificate Issuance:** Certificates will be issued only after satisfactory completion of the assigned period and tasks
- **Stipend Disbursement:** A monthly stipend of Rs. 5,000/- will be paid to postgraduate interns upon submission and approval of their monthly report
